

CPL QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE

The following table outlines the most common Continuous Professional Learning (CPL) activities and the associated Claimable Learning Units (LUs), including any applicable maximums (*max*) allowable per year or per activity. Please refer to the full System Guide for more details.

STRUCTURED

Courses, meetings, seminars, lectures, presentations, workshops, sessions, or similar

Activity	Claimable Learning Units (LUs)
Attending or leading a tour, field study, or mobile workshop	< 3 hrs: 1.0 LU 3 – 6 hrs: 2.5 LUs ≥ 6 hrs: 4.0 LUs
Attending courses, webinars, workshops, seminars, lectures, sessions (separate from day-to-day work duties)	1.0 LU per 1 hr
Preparation of material for organized lecture, workshop, seminar, presentation, or conference session	1.0 LU per 1 hr – <i>max</i> 4.0 LUs
Researching & writing a professional or academic article, book, or text for review and organized publication	3.0 – 6.0 LUs (depending on length/complexity)
Volunteering as formal mentor or sponsor for Candidate member going through certification process	1.0 LU per contact hr – <i>max</i> 4.0 LUs per year

CANDIDATE GUIDE

Structured:

- Receiving formal mentorship from a Certified member: 1.0 LU per contact hr – max 4.0 LUs per year
- PSB Ethics & Professionalism
 Course & Test: 1.0 LU per hr –
 max 3.0 LUs
- "Road to Your RPP" Webinar: 1.25
- Professional Examination: 1.0 LU per hr *max* 3.0 LUs

Unstructured:

- Preparation of the Record of Practical Work Experience: 1.0 LU per hr max 4.0 LUs
- Preparation for PSB Professional Examination: 1.0 LU per hr – max 4.0 LUs

UNSTRUCTURED

Must be purposeful and educational; must yield new planning or professional knowledge; and must be relevant & applicable to member's practice of planning

Activity	Claimable Learning Units (LUs)
 Volunteer participation on: PIBC, CIP, PSB or other relevant professional board, committee, or similar role relevant civic, community, or advisory body, board, or committee (NOT part of normal work duties) 	Hours of work/meetings per year: < 5 hrs: 2.0 LUs 5 – 20 hrs: 3.5 LUs > 20 hrs: 5.0 LUs
Undertaking a self-directed tour, field study, etc.	< 3 hrs: 1.0 LU 3 – 6 hrs: 2.0 LUs ≥ 6 hrs: 4.0 LUs
Teaching outside of normal professional work	1.0 LU per 1 hr
Independent research	1.0 LU per 1 hr
Reading/review of a relevant journal, academic, or professional article	1.0 LU <i>max</i> per reading
Reading/review of a relevant academic or professional book, text, or similar publication	3.0 LUs <i>max</i> per reading
Volunteering as an informal mentor to a student or other individual interested in planning (outside of the membership certification process for Candidate members)	1.0 LU per contact hr – max 4.0 LUs per year

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Structured learning does not have to be provided by PIBC, CIP, or other affiliates.
 Courses/webinars/activities
 - presented by other companies or organizations can be claimed as structured learning.
- Do not report items that are part of your everyday work, but supplemental training provided through work is acceptable
- Report as you go don't wait until the end of the year
- Provide detailed descriptions or activities
- Report conference sessions separately – don't report attending a conference as a single activity
- Correctly register for PIBC webinars (group versus individual)
- Keep receipts or proof of attendance for 2 years in case selected for further review
