The Township of Langley is currently recruiting for a regular full-time **Landscape Design Technician** to join our team of professionals in the Community Development Division; Green Infrastructure Services Department. Reporting to the Manager, Green Infrastructure Services, in this unionized position you will join a dynamic multi-disciplinary team of professionals, applying your creativity, breadth of landscape architecture and development related knowledge and experience. The work is technical in nature and will require significant coordination with other Township departments.

Responsibilities:

- Administer Township landscape requirements, review designs and specifications for conformance to applicable community and neighbourhood plan requirements, bylaws, policies, and conditions
- Coordinate the municipal street tree and boulevard planting programs and ensure accurate as-built plans are prepared for development projects
- Coordinate aspects of the Municipal Street Tree & Boulevard Planting Policy through all phases of the development review process
- Compile development generated landscape statistics relating to trees, trails and development types

Qualifications:

- Graduation from a 2 year diploma program in Landscape Design, Urban Design or Landscape Architecture and a minimum of 2 years directly related experience, preferably with landscape construction experience
- Strong interpersonal, verbal and written communication skills and thorough knowledge of landscape design principles and practices, landscape construction methods and skill in the use of computerized drafting and design software
- Commitment to providing excellent customer service through teamwork, communication, and responsiveness
