## Position Overview

The Peace River Regional District (PRRD) has an opportunity for an effective and innovative professional with initiative and leadership qualities. Reporting to the General Manager of Development Services or designate, the primary duties of the Planning Services Manager will be day-to-day planning staff oversight and guidance on technical matters related to the processing of development applications.
