

## PLANNING TECHNICIAN - ASSOCIATE PLANNER FULL-TIME POSITION

**SUMMARY:** Reporting directly to the Manager of Planning Services, the self-motivated and innovative incumbent will be responsible for providing planning support services to the general public and regional district staff.

## MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS/REQUIREMENTS:

- Bachelor's degree in Planning, Geography or closely related field supplemented by urban planning courses or a diploma and/or certificate in planning.
- Related work experience preferably within a local government planning environment.
- Strong written and verbal communication skills are required.
- Demonstrated computer skills in Microsoft Office Suite (Outlook, Word, and Excel).
- Experience with mapping software would be considered an asset.

**WAGE:** This is a BCGEU position. The terms of this position include a wage rate of \$32.42 per hour. A standard probation period will apply.

**WORK SITE LOCATION:** Cariboo Regional District Williams Lake Office located at Suite D, 180 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue North, Williams Lake, BC. Occasional travel within the regional district will be required.

**HOURS OF WORK:** 70 hours bi-weekly, on occasion may be required to work a non-standard schedule to accommodate the attendance of evening meetings or for presentations. This position will work a 9-day fortnight schedule.
