#### **Position Overview**

The Peace River Regional District invites applicants for the full-time position of Land Use Planner at our office in Fort St. John, BC. This position will be of interest to those seeking a planning career in a developing rural setting that is at the heart of BC's energy resources sector.

Reporting to the General Manager of Development Services or designate, responsibilities include processing and review of development applications, report and mapping preparation, conducting public meetings, and responding to inquiries from the public, other staff, elected officials and government referrals. There will also be opportunity to conduct and assist with planning research projects and policy development.

### Qualifications

The ideal candidate will have:

- a post-secondary degree in planning or a related discipline and two years of related experience;
