Summarized Position Responsibilities:

The City has positions available within either the current (development) or long-range (policy) planning units.

The development-focused planning staff will support the Planning and Development team in managing various land use applications in a high-growth, fast-paced environment. These positions are responsible for development applications such as Official Community Plan and Zoning Bylaw amendments, Comprehensive Development Plans, Development Permits (residential, industrial, and commercial), agricultural applications and subdivisions.

Policy planning staff will implement the city's vision in preparing land use bylaws, policies, and key housing initiatives while ensuring compliance with applicable legislation. These positions will draft RFPs, administer and project manage consultant-led projects, as well as lead various in-house policy planning projects. The Long Range planning team provides recommendations in the development of policy through the assembly, analysis, and interpretation of statistical, demographic, environmental, and other relevant data.
